Skills and Attributes

Head Coach Tom Lamonica states "As a first year player, Max performed at an all-conference level. This past season, Max was good on 17 PATs only missing on one that was blocked. He also made 2 of his 3 field goal attempts from 22 and 32 yards. Max has shown that during practice Max he kicks 40-45 yard field goals. On kickoffs, Max consistently put the ball inside the 5 yard line. He also beat out an all-conference kicker from the previous year. He was an excellent cornerback on defense and shows a lot of promise at either position." Max is consistent from 35 yards and in. While he hasn't had much of an opportunity to kick from further out, he does have a strong leg and sound mechanics in only his first year of kicking. He rarely hits the ball poorly and the ball gets up quickly. As Max's leg gets even stronger, so should his kickoffs which average good distance and hang time already. Although Max did not punt during his Junior year, he will be during his senior year. During practice, Max averages 35+ yards from scrimmage. Max has attended several kicking camps to improve his distance, accuracy and leg strength. Academically, Max attends an elite private high school where the majority of his classes are AP equivalent level courses. Max understands the importance of performing in the classroom and continues to push himself in and out of the classroom. He is a solid collegiate kicking prospect and is poised to make a huge impact at the next level.
